**Location:**

@ Island Grove Regional Park  
(NW Side of the Arena, under the Grand Stands – see map on last page)  
501 N 14th Ave, Greeley, CO 80631  
Outside on concrete, under cover.

The trial will be held outdoors. The ring will be under cover on matted concrete. It may be HOT. Please be prepared. There will be no indoor crating. There may be some shade for crating but that is not guaranteed. You can also set up canopies (at your own risk) but you will need to bring weights to secure them.

Disruptive dogs will have to be crated outside of the trial area. If your dog cannot handle other dogs or people walking past their crate, plan to crate outside the trial area. Please bring adequate shade.

There will be no electricity supplied. See map on last page.

**PARKING:** There will be parking allowed just outside the barn hunt area. However - DO NOT BLOCK THE FENCE OPENING IN ANY WAY. Do not park in an RV spot unless you have an RV reservation. Do not block any other vehicles. You will be asked to move immediately.

**Wednesday:** Set-up will start around 10am. If you are available to help please let me know! After Barn Hunt and Fast CAT are set up, we will have Barn Hunt practice. We will send out a message through Remind (info below) when we know a time. **Priority for practice goes to those helping set up!**

**Thurs/Fri/Sat/Sun:** Site will open at 7am. Briefing at 8am with trials to follow. A lunch and other breaks may be taken at the judge's and/or club's discretion. There may be practice on Thursday after the trials are done. We will send out a message through Remind (info below) if practice times will be available. **Trial helpers have priority for practice!**

***Help setting up, cleaning up, and throughout the trial is greatly appreciated and makes for a much quicker day!***  
We are always in need of rat wranglers, scribes, course builders, leash runners, sheet runners, gate stewards, etc. Most of these jobs are easy, but necessary for the trial to run. We are happy to train anyone in any position! Thank you!!!

### Conflicts:

We would like to accommodate each and every conflict but sometimes that is impossible and you may have to make a choice. The running order for classes will be posted at the ring each day. Please notify the blind steward of your conflict BEFORE we are running your class so we can discuss how to best accommodate.

We cannot hold a class.

If you are not present by the time your class ends, you will not be able to run your dog in that class for that trial. There are two trials each day but a missed run in trial one cannot be run in trial two and cannot be moved to another day. Missed runs are not eligible for a refund.

### RECEIVE TEXT NOTIFICATIONS:

Many of you are have other events in addition to Barn Hunt. We've set up an account with a text message service that will **send out alerts** regarding classes we are running. ### Running Order:

**Thursday, Friday, Saturday** we will be running UP in levels – Instinct 1 will be immediately followed by Instinct 2, Novice 1 will be immediately followed by Novice 2, Open 1 followed by Open 2, etc.

**Sunday** we will be running DOWN in levels – C8 followed by Master 1, Master 2, Senior 1, Senior 2, C8 2, Open 1, Open 2, Instinct 1, Instinct 2, Novice 1, Novice 2.

Lunch breaks will be taken at judge's discretion.

## *But What Time Will My Class Start?*

We get a lot of questions on "when will my class start" for trials. We cannot give out times other than the start of the first class of the day. However, here is a way for you to estimate when your class MAY start running:

On RockyMountainRatters.com under the event page for these trials you'll find a "Judge Limits and Scheduling Chart".

Above, we give entry counts as of the pre-entry closing along with the order the classes will run.

You can multiply out the estimated judging time per run x the entries in each class to get a rough estimate. However, please note that this doesn't include absent dogs, move-ups, day-of-show/late entries, etc. And runs don't always last the "estimated" judging time per run. There are no refunds/credits/moves for missed runs. Calculate at your own risk!

## Parking:

See notes on first page. Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

Event / club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. We will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

## Miscellaneous Notes:

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. **FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON TRIAL GROUNDS.** Electronic collars, bark collars, and head halters are not allowed to be used on the trial grounds. **Dogs are required to run "naked" and should be brought into the ring with collars/harnesses/slip leads which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced.**

**CRATING:** The trial will be held outdoors. There may be some crating in the shade but it isn't guaranteed. It may be HOT. Please be prepared. There will be no electricity supplied. You can bring canopies/tents at your own risk but they will need weights. See a RMR official for information on where to set up. Please clean up after yourselves!!

Disruptive dogs will have to be crated outside of the trial area. If your dog cannot handle other dogs or people walking past their crate, plan to crate outside the trial area. Please bring adequate shade.

**Potting:** Please be sure to pick up after your dog. Please keep your dog from peeing on the side of the building, or on any items that people have to pick up! Please clean up any accidents in the building immediately.

**Food/Drinks:** There will be vendors on site. Feel free to bring your own food.

**Bathrooms:** There are bathrooms on site in the main building, but it may be a bit of a walk.

**Rules:** The concrete area under the grandstands as marked is Barn Hunt Trial Grounds. While on barn hunt trial grounds, barn hunt rules are in effect. It is the responsibility of each competitor to read and understand the current Barn Hunt Association, LLC Rules prior to participating in this event. <http://www.barnhunt.com/forms/barnhuntrules.pdf>

**Bitches in Season:** BIS are eligible to compete but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and run in panties/britches at the end of their class, regardless of height. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the Trial Secretary prior to the trial. You must also make sure the Judge informs all exhibitors at the briefing. A separate crating area is available for BIS competitors.

Island Grove Park - 11th Ave N & D St

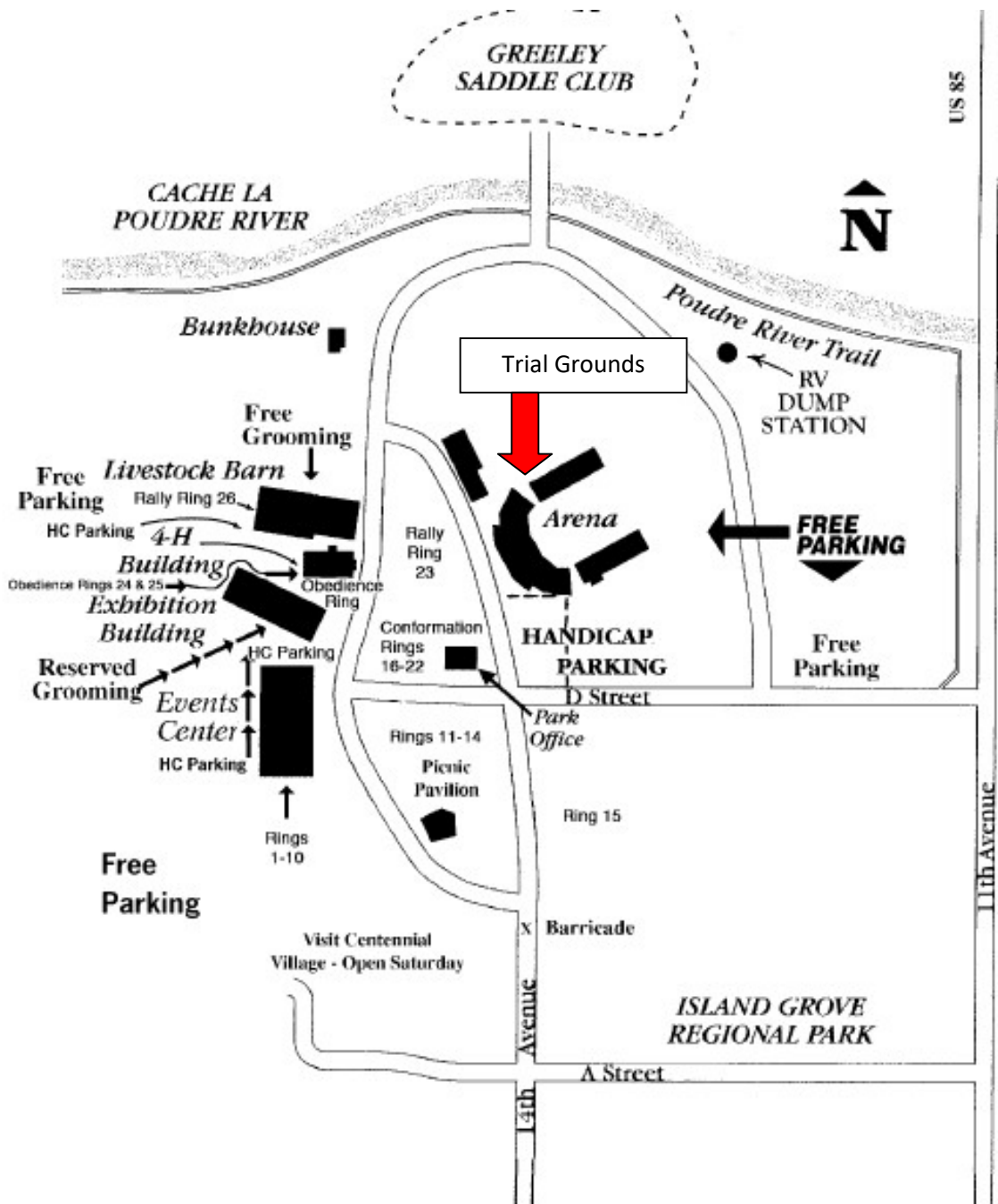
**USE 11TH AVE**

**FROM THE NORTH** - From Hwy 85 take the 11th Ave exit. Proceed South to park entrance.

**FROM THE SOUTH** - From Hwy 85 take the 5th St exit & go west to 11th Ave. Proceed north on 11th Ave to park entrance.

**FROM THE EAST OR WEST** - From Hwy 34 Business Route take 11th Ave north to park entrance.

**FROM INTERSTATE 25 NORTH OR SOUTH** - Take Hwy 34 East to Business Hwy 34 exit, continue east to 11th Ave. Proceed north on 11th Ave to park entrance.
